Fall Registration Fees

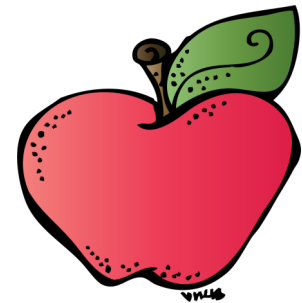
Annual registration fees are due for all families who enrolled prior to June 1, 2022. Registration fees are as follows:

Transition Time At Kids R Kids

5. Remember to validate any feelings of apprehension your child may be having, while being positive and excited about the experiences the new school year will bring.
6. When dropping off in the new class, make it a quick and easy good-bye. If there are a few tears, we will give lots of hugs and love!
