

Our Safety Response to COVID-19

Since our main goal is the safety of our families and staff, we have implemented some new health and safety policies. We follow all protocol and safety recommendations from the CDC, our governor, state licensing-Bright from the Start, Kids 'R' Kids International, and other advisory boards.

- Hospital-grade REME-HALO Air Purification System constantly kills 99% of viruses in air and on surfaces and kills 99% of sneeze germs within 3 feet. Instead of 1 centralized HVAC system, we have multiple individual units that prevent germs from being spread from one area of the school to another.
- Zono Sanitech Machine- We use our sanitizing machine for classroom toys and materials daily-kills 99% surface germs and viruses.
- In addition, we clean, sanitize, and disinfect multiple times throughout the day in each classroom. Toys and other classroom items are being rotated in and out as they are cleaned.
- Naptime mats are placed 6ft apart in the classrooms.
- Until the governor lifts the social distancing requirements, we are practicing social distancing by limiting our classroom sizes to 10 in total including teachers.
- Each classroom is a self-contained unit that does not mix with any other group of children.
- Everyone returning to the school must be healthy no cold symptoms, no fever over 100.4, no other type of illness/virus/respiratory type infection, or no exposure to COVID 19.
- Teachers and children have their temperature checked and recorded daily outside the front door. Anything above 100.4 is considered a fever. Anyone with a higher temperature is not allowed to enter the building.
- Anyone with a fever must stay out of the building for 48 hours (2 complete school days) longer than our usual "one day home" illness policy.
- "Kiss and Go" at the front door- NO parents are allowed to enter the building even for Suite 100 and 150 children. We will take your children back to the classrooms for you. Please communicate any information needed for the teacher through Tadpoles before you leave home that morning or the evening before.
- As you are 10 minutes out from arriving at the school in the afternoon, please call us to bring your child to the front door for you.
- To prevent contamination from a shared attendance log-in computer, the administrators will check your child in and out daily.
- All tuition payments may be paid online (www.myprocare.com) or by handing us a check at the front door. If you are already part of Tuition Express automated payment system, we will process your tuition payment for you. We will not be able to process a credit card or take a cash payment on site for the short term.
- All classes eat meals in their room to prevent cross-contamination with another group.
- Playgrounds are sanitized between access for each class of students.
- On a rainy day when the café is used for indoor play, it is also sanitized between use by groups of students.
- As the situation changes, we are constantly looking for more strategies to make our school a safe and healthy environment for everyone.
