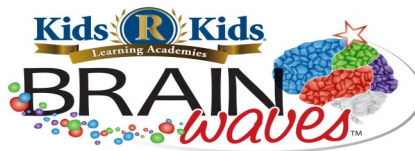


Thurs. July 25 is National Sundae day!

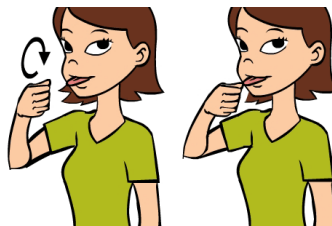


### Occipital Lobe Activity

### Favorite Activities
