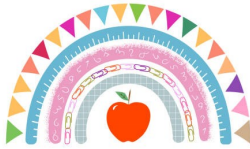

FAVORITE ACTIVITIES

1. WE WILL ENCOURAGE THE INFANTS TO COME AND SIT WITH US TO LOOK AT BUTTERFLY PICTURES TO EXPLORE THEIR DIFFERENT COLORS.
2. WE WILL ENCOURAGE THE INFANTS TO PAINT WITH FEATHERS USING DIFFERENT COLORED PAINTS, IDENTIFYING THE COLORS AS THEY PAINT.
3. WE WILL ENCOURAGE THE INFANTS TO COME AND SIT WITH US TO READ A BOOK ABOUT FLOWERS WHILE READING, WE WILL IDENTIFY THE COLORS.
4. WE WILL PLAY PEEK-A-BOO WITH THE INFANTS ASKING THEM WHERE THE DIFFERENT FRUITS/VEGETABLES ARE.
