Preparation: Preview video.

- Ask questions about the video, ex: "What bird laid the largest egg?" "How can you tell the difference between a turkey and a duck egg?"

- 2. Provide materials and encourage your child to cut out animals that can be found at a barn.




Barn Dance

- Ask questions about the video, ex: "What are some characteristics of a male turkey?" "How do you measure a pony?"




The Cow that Went Oink

- 2. Encourage your child to guess the sounds of the animals.




Mrs. Wishy Washy's Farm



- 2. Continue activity if interest remains.




Scarecrow

Preparation: Preview video. Instructions:


- 1. Enjoy this wonderful story about life on the farm from a scarecrow's point of view!
