2. While listening to the story, stop and point out the yellow things you see throughout the book.



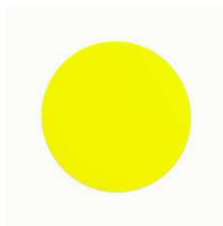
Yellow Circle

2. Assist your baby as he/she colors in the circle.

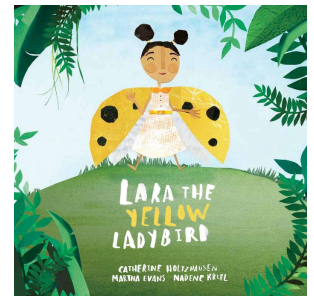

Materials: yellow paint, paper

Preparation: Gather materials.

Instructions:

1. Hold your baby and say, "We are going to make yellow handprints."
2. Paint your baby's hand and gently press it on the paper.
3. Allow your baby to imitate your actions.
4. Enjoy this priceless art.

Yellow Collage

Materials: yellow objects, paper, glue

Preparation: Gather materials.

Instructions:

1. Hold your baby and say, "We are going to glue the yellow objects on the paper."
2. Assist your baby with gluing the objects.
3. Name the objects to encourage language development.



Sign Language "Up"

Instructions:

1. Hold your baby and say, "We are going to sign the word 'up.'"
2. Hold up your index finger with palm facing forward and move it up slightly pointing upward.



Patty Yellow

Materials: yellow paper, tape, scissors

Preparation: Cut out yellow circles and tape them to your hands.

Instructions:

1. Hold your baby and say, "We are going to sing a short version of Patty Cake."

(Clap hands together)
Circles Yellow

(open your hands to show the yellow circles)

2. Observe as your baby engages in active play. Encourage your baby to imitate your actions.
3. Continue as interest remains.



Sunshine is Yellow

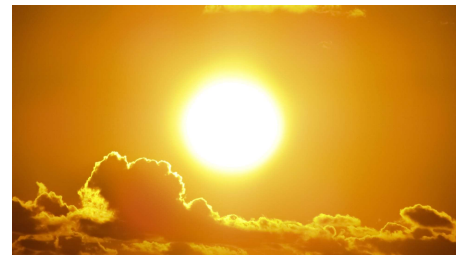
Materials: internet access, website:

Yellow Everywhere

Materials: paper, yellow paint

Preparation: Gather materials.

Instructions:

1. Hold your baby and say, "We are going paint with your hands using yellow paint."
2. Paint his/her hands.
3. Encourage and assist your baby with rubbing the paint on the paper.
4. Observe as your baby explores paint.

2. Hold up your index finger with palm facing forward and move it up slightly pointing upward.



Yellow is Falling

Materials: yellow paper

Preparation: Tear paper into large strips.

Instructions:

1. Hold your baby and say, "We are going to watch the yellow paper fall down."
2. Encourage your baby to assist you as you toss the paper up.
3. Depending on age/development, observe your baby as he/she attempts to imitate your actions.



Yellow Fellow

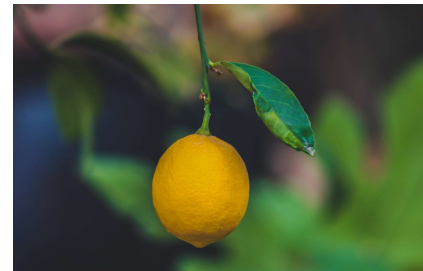
