Day 1 | Week 23

My Family

Materials: family photos, small photo album **Preparation:** Gather materials. Place family photos in album.

Instructions:

- 1. Assist and modify as needed.
- 2. Show your baby the photo album and point to pictured family members.
- 3. Observe your baby for reaction as you talk about your family members.




The Birthday Pet

Materials: internet access, website: https://youtu.be/yW6-ql4mtD0
Preparation: Preview video.

Instructions:

- 1. Gather your baby and listen to the book.
- 2. Point to the illustrations and discuss what is in the pictures.



Family Painting

Materials: three different colors of paint, one freezer gallon zipper bag, sheet of paper able to fit in bag

Preparation: Gather materials. Place droplets of paint on the paper, then place paper in freezer gallon zipper bag. Zip bag and ensure properly closed.

Instructions:

- 1. Gather your baby. Assist and modify as needed.
- 2. Support your baby in exploring how the colors mix in the zipper bag.



Sign Language "Eat"

- 1. Hold your baby and say, "We are going to sign 'eat."
- 2. Place the flattened "O" hand toward the mouth once for the word "eat."
- 3. Some people use the sign for "eat" and "food" interchangeably, while others sign "eat" twice for the word "food."





Day 2 Week 23

In My World

Materials: pictures of friends Preparation: Gather materials.

Instructions:

- 1. Show your baby the pictures of friends.
- 2. Point to the pictures and say the friends' names.
- 3. Show your baby pictures of family pets.



Instructions:

- 1. Listen to the read aloud book with your
- 2. Point and repeat names of objects to promote language development.



Hello

Materials: phone (non-working) Preparation: Gather material.

Instructions:

- 1. Gather your baby. Assist and modify as needed. Use the toy phone to start a conversation with someone your baby knows. For example, you could pretend to call a grandparent.
- 2. As you talk, change your voice, using higher and lower pitch and volume. Mention your baby's name.
- 3. Put the phone next to your baby's ear and say, "It's for you!" Listen for babbles and coos in response.

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Day 3 | Week 23

Family Talk

Instructions:

- 1. Gather your baby. As they coo, gurgle, growl, or giggle, respond by imitating these sounds. This will create a back and forth conversation.
- 2. Remember to maintain eye contact as you "talk" to each other.
- 3. Continue activity as long as interest remains.



If You're Happy and You Know It

Materials: internet access, website: https://youtu.be/13wd8KvOt58
Preparation: Preview video.

Instructions:

- 1. Gather your baby.
- 2. As you sit with your baby in your lap, sing "If You're Happy and You Know It."
- 3. Take your baby's hands in yours and encourage your baby to clap to the beat with you.



My Reflection

Materials: mirror

Preparation: Gather materials.

Instructions:

- 1. Assist and modify as needed. Gather your baby. Walk your baby to a mirror.
- 2. Point to your baby and say your baby's name.
- 3. Point to yourself and say your name and who you are to your baby.
- Point to family, friends, and pets that are near as you say their names and say, "People in My World."
- 5. Observe your baby's eagerness and delight in self, others, and surroundings.



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Day 4 | Week 23

Making Music

Materials: two different size plastic containers with proper lid, uncooked beans, uncooked pasta

Preparation: Gather your materials. Place one cup of uncooked beans in the container with lid and ensure it is completely closed. Do the same for pasta.

Instructions:

- 1. Assist and modify as needed.
- 2. Shake the containers to make funs sounds.
- Observe the vocalizations your baby makes as he/she plays with the container and makes different sounds.



My Body Sing Along Song

Materials: internet access, website: https://youtu.be/-6-Q1yTEx54

Preparation: Preview video.

Instructions:

- 1. Gather your baby.
- 2. As you sit with your baby in your lap, sing along with the song "My Body."
- 3. Gently point to your baby's hands and toes as you sing along.



Family Painting

Materials: colors of finger paint representing your family's favorite colors, paper, wipes **Preparation:** Gather materials.

Instructions:

- 1. Assist and modify as needed. Gather your baby.
- Create art as you and your baby finger paint using your family's favorite colors, representing all the people in your baby's world.
- 3. As you paint, point and say the names of the colors.



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Day 5 Week 23

My World

Materials: different colors of paper, scissors, tape

Preparation: Cut different color strips of paper. Gently tape a strip of paper on each of your fingers on one hand.

Instructions:

- 1. Assist and modify as needed.
- Promote hand and eye coordination with your baby by holding your hand up and counting your fingers.
- 3. Observe as your infant finds interest in finger play.
- 4. The world is filled with different shapes and colors. Name the different colors as your baby reaches.

Twinkle, Twinkle Little Star

Materials: internet access, website:

Instructions:

- 1. Gather your baby.
- 2. Observe how your baby responds as you gently hold your baby and rock to the rhythm of the music.
- 3. You may also gently pat your baby with the beat as you rock.



Explore

Materials: three different size age-appropriate toys

Preparation: Gather materials.

Instructions:

- 1. Assist and modify as needed. Gather your baby.
- 2. Gently place your baby on his/her tummy.
- Place the toys in front of your baby.
 Observe as your baby explores objects with different characteristics.



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
