Their classroom is full of curiosity, creativity, and hands-on learning—especially in our newly re-designed STEAM Lab here at KRK Montville, now a special space for discovery and exploration.

our revamped STEAM Lab is more than just a classroom—it's a place where children explore, build, create, and learn through play. Here, students investigate exciting concepts using hands-on activities that help them understand the world around them.

STEAM stands for Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Mathematics. In our school, STEAM learning helps children develop problem-solving skills, creativity, teamwork, and confidence. Through fun, interactive activities, children learn to ask questions, try new ideas, and work together.

Ms. Taisha and Ms. Erica intentionally design engaging learning experiences that allow students to explore STEAM concepts in fun and meaningful ways. In the STEAM Lab, children participate in activities such as:

- Constructing structures using blocks, loose parts, and recycled materials
- Experimenting with ramps, magnets, water, light, and shadows
- Exploring colors, textures, and art-based designs
- Solving puzzles and sequencing challenges
- Measuring, sorting, counting, and patterning using hands-on math materials
- Exploring nature-based learning with plants, seeds, and soil investigations

Together, Suite 400 and the STEAM Lab help develop confident thinkers, creative problem-solvers, and future leaders by encouraging exploration, teamwork, and innovation every day.
