- 2. Help your child build his/her shape house.





- 2. Encourage your child to make a face using the materials, snap a photo, and then eat.





- 2. Help him/her find the various shapes, ex: circle, rectanlge, square, triangle, etc.




Spot Goes to the Park



- 2. Encourage him/her to find the items that match the colors and place on the paper.




Dinner at the Panda Place

- 3. Have your toddler look left and then right when the mouse comes in.








