

Scarecrow Band

Materials: pots, pans, spoons (wooden and metal), cups, metal bowls, colander

Preparation: Gather materials.

Instructions:

1. Show your child the pots and pans.
2. Say, "We are going to make music like the pans that were hanging on the scarecrow in the story."
3. Encourage your child to experiment with the different items and listen to the sounds.



2. Ask questions, ex: "Why were the animals scared of the scarecrow?" "What happened to the scarecrow when it snowed?"




Scarecrow Expressions

Materials: Scarecrow Expressions template, scissors

Preparation: Print and cut out template.

Instructions:

1. Show your child the scarecrow body and faces.
2. Encourage him/her to put a face on the scarecrow, say how the scarecrow is feeling, and then change up the faces.



Scarecrow Yoga

Preparation: Locate a safe, open area.

Instructions:

1. Tell your child that he/she is going to exercise like a "scarecrow."
2. Stand with your feet shoulder width apart while keeping your tummy muscles tight.
3. Move your arms slightly out like a scarecrow.
4. Now, breathe in and out and sway side to side in the wind.

Scarecrow by Dr. Jean



3. Pivot the knuckle of the dominant closed index finger or "A" thumb back and forth on the cheek.




Find & Build a Scarecrow

3. Once all parts are found, have your child put the scarecrow together.



The Gardener and the Scarecrow



3. Have your child move around his/her arms and legs to scare away the birds.




















