Firework Safety

Watching fireworks can be one of the most fun activities of the summer. It is always recommended to watch professional shows instead of using fireworks at home. However, if you do use home fireworks, the National Safety Council recommends adhering to the following guidelines to keep you and your children safe:



1. Make sure it is legal to shoot fireworks where you live.
2. Never allow young children to handle fireworks.
3. Older children should only use fireworks under adult supervision.
4. Anyone using fireworks or standing near them should wear eye protection.
5. Never hold a lit firework.
6. Never light fireworks indoors.
7. Never point or throw fireworks toward another person, home, or flammable object.
8. Never light fireworks in a container.
9. Never try and relight a malfunctioning firework.
10. Keep a bucket of water nearby.
11. Never use illegal fireworks.

Make Your Own Yarn Bowl

Materials Needed:

- Plastic Wrap
- 2 Bowls
- Yarn
- Scissors
- School Glue
- Water

1. Cover one bowl in plastic wrap and place upside down.
2. Squeeze glue into the other bowl and add a little water to dilute. Mix well.
3. Cut long pieces of yarn and dip them in the glue mixture.
4. Wrap the yarn around the bowl that is covered in plastic wrap. Let dry.
5. Once dry, remove the yarn bowl.
