When we were children, we all declared we'd never treat our children in some of the ways our parents treated us when they got angry. Now that we are parents, we may find ourselves reacting in many of the same ways we said we would not repeat.



Try to think before you react to your child. Try to remember how you felt when you were small – how easily you could be hurt and frightened by those on whom you depended for guidance and comfort.

When you do react in a way you think was unfair or overly harsh, let your child know how you feel. It's helpful for her to see that you too can make mistakes – and say so. It will build her trust in you. And it may make her more considerate of your feelings in the future as well.

It's not always easy to behave toward our children as we would want to. Try to accept yourself as you are, and do the best you can.

No one can be kind, considerate, fair, patient, and respectful all the time. Be as understanding of yourself as you are of your child.

A Snoopy Thanksgiving

With the crazy hustle and bustle of Thanksgiving, here is a fun and silly family night celebration you can have with your children.

Ingredients:

1 Loaf White bread
1 cup butter
1 cup popcorn
1 tablespoon oil
Salt to taste
Jelly Beans



Directions:

Toast bread in toaster. Butter toast, stack high. In large pot, over medium high heat, add oil. Add in popcorn kernels and cover. Shake pot vigorously. When popping begins, lift cover off just a smidge so steam escapes but popcorn does not. When popping slows to 1 kernel per second, remove from heat. Add salt and pour into a large bowl. Add butter if desired. Place all items on a plate and add a serving of Jelly Beans and enjoy!

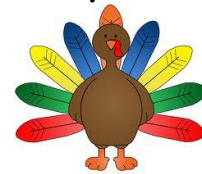
