Think, Don't React

Teaching you kids to call 911!

These are 5 tips from your St. Charles County Ambulance District Paramedics.

1. **Designate a Space.** If your household is cell-only, designate a space – such as the kitchen counter – where kids know where to find your phone. Make a conscious effort to place your phone in this location when you are home.
2. **How to Dial out.** Keep security features such as thumb print scan or password in mind when working with young kids. Consider instructing them to touch the 'emergency' button on the lock screen- this will likely be easier than fully unlocking the phone.
3. **Anticipate Questions.** The 911 dispatcher will start by asking for the address and phone number the child is calling from, and a brief summary of the emergency. The dispatcher may ask some follow-up questions about the situation, particularly if the call is medical in nature. Children should answer these questions to the best of their ability, but reassure them that it's ok if they don't know everything they are being asked.
4. **Follow Directions.** The dispatcher may ask the child to perform certain tasks prior to emergency crews' arrival, such as unlocking the front door or placing pets in a secure location. Ensure kids know that it's important to follow these instructions.
5. **Practice Makes Perfect.** Like any skill you're trying to help kids learn, repetition is key. Routinely quiz them on their address, have them show you how they'd get to the dial screen on your phone, and help them understand how to briefly describe an emergency situation.

Halloween Costume Tips:

- *Costumes should be flame retardant.
- *If your child is wearing a popular costume, make theirs unique with lights or jewelry.
- *Make sure your child will be visible to drivers-reflector strips, glow sticks and flash lights are great additions.
- *If a costume has a mask, make sure ventilation is adequate and eye holes are big enough to see out of
- *If a costume includes props (sword, knife, wand, etc.) make sure it is made with flexible plastic.
